Pick Up and Drop Off Zone

One our biggest concerns is the safety of all the children at Salem Elementary. We would like to remind everyone to please use the drop off zones when picking up and dropping off students. At Salem Elementary there are two drop off zones. One is on the North side of the school, which is off Center Street. Another one is located on the south side of the school, which is 100 south. **We ask that you please use the curb that runs along the school, not across the street, so that students do not have to cross traffic. We also ask that you follow the traffic rules and do not flip a U-Turn.** Please do not use the bus zone near the gym or the parking lots found on the South side near the Kindergarten classes or the parking lot on the West side in front of the school. We appreciate your efforts in being patient as traffic flows and for helping us keep all kids' safe.
