## Report on Current Year's Goals

School Name: Salem Elementary

Report on School Year: 2016-2017

Goal 1: To continue to improve academic results in all the core areas of instruction by having teachers collaborate in teams and creating and maintaining a professional learning community.
Proposed Measurements of Success: We will use formal and informal assessment to assure student academic improvement in Math, Language Arts, and Science. (I.e. Benchmarks, Running Records, Sage Testing, Dibbles, common assessments, and teacher observations.)
Written Report or Supporting Data: We continue to facilitate team and individual teachers to observe effective collaboration practices. This has been done within our own school and we have visited other schools. We discuss best practices of collaboration in our monthly staff meetings as well as literacy collaboration. We also continue to analyze data collected by benchmarks, running records, Sage Testing, Dibbles, common assessments, and teacher observations. We take the data and adjust instruction as well as place students in intervention programs to meet student's needs.
Goal 2: Students will improve proficiency in grade level language arts concepts. (One letter jump per term and or at grade level)
Proposed Measurements of Success: Student mastery will be measured by looking at yearly end-of-level Language Arts Test Scores, Benchmark, and Dibbles Scores.
Written Report or Supporting Data: We are still waiting for end of level testing results and the last benchmark results. Our previous benchmarks data and Dibbles data are showing promising growth with student progress.
Goal 3: Salem Elementary will regularly integrate Fine Arts curriculum into classroom instruction.
Proposed Measurements of Success: Updated curriculum maps will evidence Fine Arts instruction along with classroom observations.
Written Report or Supporting Data: Principal collects maps at the beginning of the year and does both formal and informal observations to assure that the maps are being followed and integration is happening. We have seen an increase of application with the help of our Art Specialist at our school and the modeling and teaching that has occurred this year.
Goal 4: Utilize technology resources to teach, review, and assess standards, objectives, and indicators of the state core curriculum. To increase communication between school and home.
Proposed Measurements of Success: We will see an increase of usage in classroom instruction.
